

Equipment	Benefits
1,600 square feet of Sof Tile Safety Surfacing (see attachment for benefits and safety information).	Children can run, walk, or roll with ease throughout the area allowing for new physical and social opportunities. More secure footing provides feeling of stability for those with mobility challenges.
Ramping to the highest point and to slide.	Height/"King of the Hill" attainable by all. Design also provides access to a slide without a step – important for those children who utilize a mobility device. Also, allows adult caregivers, with or without mobility challenges, the opportunity to engage in play with children in a way that may not have been accessible in the past.
Multiple access points of varying difficulties (ramp entrance, multiple climbers, bridges, transfer station)	Although two friends may have the same destination in mind, they are able to get there using different paths depending on their abilities. Allows for parallel play.
Multiple social areas (deck activities/benches, Rock'n Ship, NRG Hammock)	Different opportunities for children to gather and socialize or "hang out."
Rock'n Ship	Not only is this an accessible place for kids to "hang out", it offers sensory stimulation as it provides a gentle swaying motion. Ship theme and treasure map encourages imaginative play.
Independent events – (Stand-n-Spin, Solo Spinner, Jack Hammer)	For those kids that may be overwhelmed by a crowd, there are independent events surrounding the structure which allow for one or two kids to participate in an activity while obtaining necessary sensory input (e.g. joint compression and vestibular/spinning).
Various slides (spiral, wave, triple, and steel)	Multiple slides offer different sensory, physical, and social experiences. Triple slide provides opportunities to race down with a friend. A steel slide is offered to include those children with cochlear implants that cannot use a plastic slide because of the static electricity.
Innovative new climbers and events (Infinity Climber, Hoopla bridge, Team Swing, Maypole)	Events will interest the kids and challenge them physically and cognitively as they grow helping them build confidence.
Panels: Music, Braille, Telescope	Offers additional sensory and cognitive benefits.
